**About Think and Grow Rich...**It is arguably the number one success book of all time. Ask virtually any well-known "success teacher" to cite the books that have influenced them and ***Think and Grow Rich*** is likely to be named. That includes the venerable **Earl Nightingale** of yesteryear and today's success gurus like **Tony Robbins, Bob Proctor** and **Harvey Mackay**, just to name a few.
